FNEAA offers members:

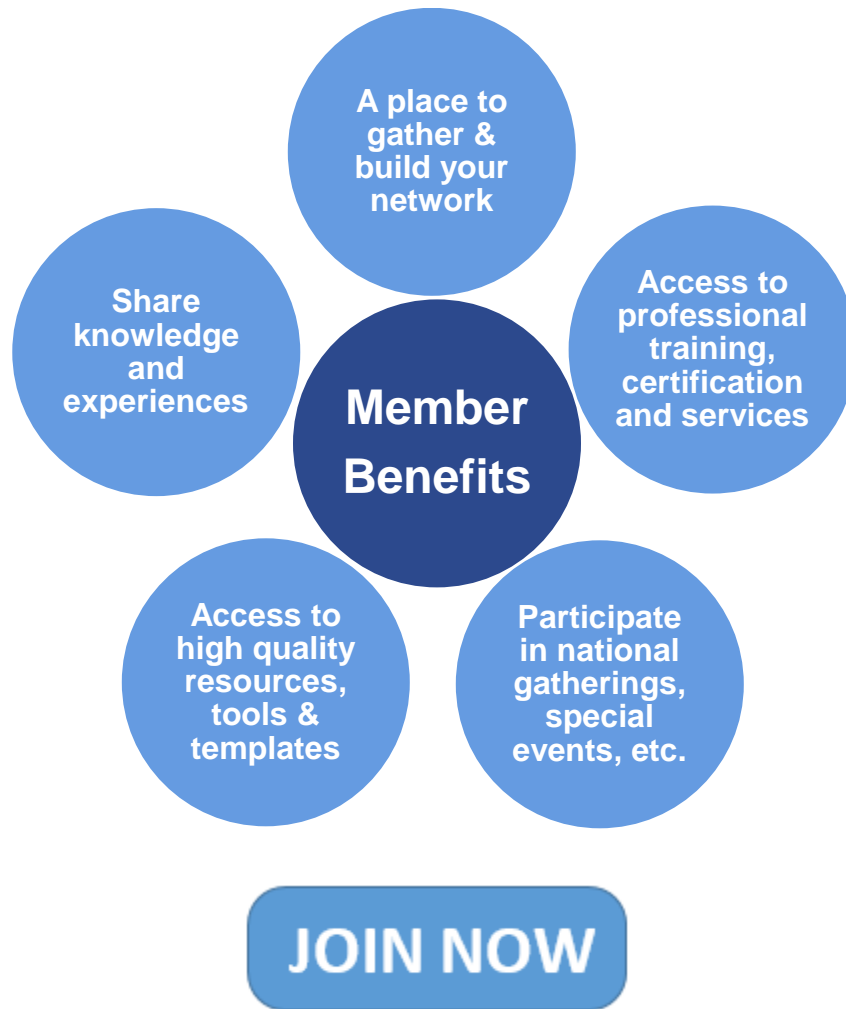
- training, education and certification programs
